Thais Muniz

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Interdisciplinary Artist Brazil, 1987

Thais Muniz is an interdisciplinary artist interested in the territories of identity, memory, belonging, transit and inward love. She has a degree in Fashion Design from Salvador University (UNIFACS) in Salvador, Brazil, and is currently studying for a Masters in Art and Collaborative Research at the Institute of Art, Design and Technology (IADT) in Dublin, Ireland. Through her artistic practices, she builds bridges and opens conversations to propose reconnections, changes and healing, from an anti-colonial perspective against countless mechanisms of collective illness. Her work mixes intimate community learning practices such as workshops, performances and installations with other modes of expression such as photography, video, collage, urban intervention and celebration, using textiles as one of her main raw materials. Thais is interested in re-appropriating stories, narratives and habits to strengthen identities and challenge the status quo. She also uses ephemerality as a possibility to propose a form of 'culture in action' where the participatory element is fundamental.

Since 2012, Muniz has been developing a body of work and research on identity, pride and self-esteem in Afro-Atlantic communities through turbans, scarves, textiles and the relationship between the non-verbal communications implied by the head and its platform <u>Turbante-se</u>. She has been creating exchange spaces, workshops and performances since 2012 for various audiences in Brazil, Europe, the United Kingdom and the United States. Since 2017 she has been organizing Escuna Sound System, an annual celebration that proposes the democratization and re-signification of transgenerational traumas in the Atlantic waters of Salvador's Todos os Santos Bay for racialized and dissident bodies. In 2017 she took part in the "Axé Bahia: The Power Of Art In An Afro-Brazilian Metropolis" at the Fowler Museum at UCLA in Los Angeles, where she also gave lectures and facilitated Turbante-se workshops at the symposium "Blackness: The Art of Empowerment in Bahia, Brazil". In 2018 she mentored young black women in the project "The Missy Elliott Project" by artist Selina Thompson at the Dublin Dance Festival. In 2019 she was a speaker at "7a Conferência Bienal Network Afroeuropeans" in Lisbon. In 2021 she presented "Darling, Don't Turn Your Back On Me" at the Royal Hibernian Academy of Arts in Dublin - a multidisciplinary work presented through text, video, performance and installation in the gallery. In 2022 she took part in the exhibition "Place After Pattern After Place", where she also presented the performance Ori Blessings at Glór Arts Centre, in Ennis, co. Clare, Ireland. In 2022, she presented the performance and installation Triangulations in Cachoeira, Bahia, Brazil, as a guest of the Africa in the Arts research group at the Center for Arts, Humanities and Letters (CAHL) of the Federal University of Reconcavo (UFRB). Based on this work, Thais developed the methodology "Inner Space of a Future Memory", consisting of a workshop, performance and collective installation, presented on three dates with different groups at the Irish Museum of Modern Art, in Dublin between June and August 2023. As part of this ongoing project, she has been working on finalizing the works developed during the immersions in Cachoeira and Dublin, which consist of documentation, the production of a photographic series, a film and a publication. In 2023 she also took part in the group exhibition <u>Uprooted Visions</u> at Edinburgh Printmakers, Scotland.

Since 2022 Muniz has been one of four artists-in-residence from the Irish Museum of Modern Art (IMMA) at The Dean Art Studios.
